Day 1

We begin our journey to Baltimore, MD with a cup of hot coffee and a snack served by a professional Bianco Tour Director. Baltimore, also known as Charm City, was founded in 1729 and is the second largest seaport in the Mid-Atlantic. On arrival, we have an included dinner at **Phillips Seafood Restaurant**. Phillips sits directly on the water, in the iconic renovated Power Plant industrial building that is now a key fixture of the Inner Harbor. After dinner, we make our way to our hotel, the **Radisson Downtown Inner Harbor**, our home for the next three nights. The Radisson has all the amenities we enjoy including a roof top outdoor pool, restaurant and lounge.

Day 2

Breakfast is included this morning before departing on a **city tour of Baltimore** with a local step on guide. We will start at the Inner Harbor to view the Christopher Columbus Statue and antique row. We will see Fort McHenry, Edgar Allen Poe's Gravesite, Basilica of the Assumption and much more as our guide narrates along the way. Our tour will end at the Inner Harbor where we will take an elevator ride to the **Top of the World Observation deck**. Top of the World features a spectacular 360-degree panoramic view of Baltimore from the 27th floor featuring the Inner Harbor and the Chesapeake Bay. This afternoon we will have a cash allowance to get some lunch on our own along with shopping time at **Harbor Place**. The heart of Baltimore's renowned Inner Harbor, Harborplace features a mix of unique shops, restaurants and diverse eateries, plus live seasonal entertainment on the waterfront. We take some time this afternoon to freshen up and relax at the hotel before departing for our big evening out. This evening we visit the **Babe Ruth Birthplace and Museum**. George Herman "Babe" Ruth was born February 6, 1895 at 216 Emory St., a Baltimore row house that is now just a long fly ball from Oriole Park at Camden Yards. The exhibits depict the Historic House, his life, accomplishments and give us a glimpse back in time at the world of young "Babe." In 1983, the operation expanded to

become the official museum of the Baltimore Orioles, the team that signed Ruth to his first professional contract. Following our visit, we make our way over to **Oriole Park at Camden Yards** to see our beloved **Detroit Tigers** take on the **Baltimore Orioles**. Cheer our favorite team to victory as we experience one of the most highly praised stadiums in baseball.

Day 3

Another included breakfast greets us this morning before departing for a full day on the Inner Harbor. Our first stop is the **Pride of Baltimore**, an authentic reproduction of a 19-century Baltimore clipper topsail schooner, a style of vessel made famous by its great success in the War of 1812. Come across the gangway and come aboard to learn about Baltimore's tall ship from her captain and crew. This afternoon, we have time for lunch on our own and shopping time in **Fell's Point**, a quaint neighborhood on Baltimore's harbor. Packed with restaurants, galleries and shops, there is something here for everyone. This afternoon, we visit the **National Aquarium** and see the world below the surface. An underwater world of beautiful and unusual animals and habitats await us. Travel to an Australian river gorge, descend through an Atlantic coral reef, explore a tropical rain forest, discover dolphins and sharks, and interact with animal experts. Our admission includes unlimited access to the Dolphin Discovery Exhibit. See the dolphins any time, for as long as you like and enjoy interactive sessions with the dolphin team, including dolphin enrichment, feedings and play activities. After time at the hotel to relax, we have an included dinner at **M & S Grill**. We'll have a scrumptious meal while enjoying the view of the harbor.

Day 4

This morning, after our included breakfast, we have an opportunity to attend church service for those who wish to attend. We'll pack our bags later this morning and begin our journey home making rest and meal stops on our own for comfort and convenience.
