Day 1

We begin our journey to Missouri this morning with a hot cup of coffee and a snack served by a professional Bianco Tour Director. Our travel day today brings us to St. Louis, MO. On arrival, we have dinner at a locally popular steakhouse located right next door to our hotel, the **Drury Plaza Hotel at the Arch**; our home for the night. Following dinner and check in, the remainder of the evening is ours to enjoy.

Day 2

After an included breakfast this morning, we depart for the **Gateway Arch**. Ride a tram 630 feet up to the top of the iconic Arch where we find an awe-inspiring view of St. Louis and the

mighty Mississippi River. Following our visit to the Arch, we make our final short trek to Branson, stopping en route for lunch on our own. We arrive this afternoon at the **Grand Oaks Hotel** in Branson, MO; our home for the next three nights. The Grand Oaks Hotel is Branson's newest renovated hotel and is centrally located in the heart of Branson, just off the strip. After some time to freshen up and relax, we'll have an included dinner before arriving at the **Acrobats of China show**. Since 1998 the Acrobats of China have wowed Branson visitors with internationally famous, award-winning Chinese Acrobats. Each year there are new performers creating a revolving line-up of awesome human performance art and dance in a unique show with a cultural storyline!

Day 3

We'll enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel this morning before departing for the **Branson Mill Craft Village**, filled with handmade and unique gifts where craftsmen and women demonstrate their talents and design one-of-a-kind gifts right before our eyes! After our visit, we depart for **Dogwood Canyon Nature Park** where we have a guided tram tour and lunch on our own with time to explore. We'll wind through the canyon floor, past towering bluffs and waterfalls, crossing creek beds by way of beautifully-crafted stone bridges and splashing through spring-fed waters. Stops will be made at the 1800's style Hope Wedding Chapel, Thunder Falls Crossing to feed the fish, and Glory Hole (a magnificent blue-green pool where some of the largest trout reside). We will then, cross the Arkansas border and enter the Bison-Elk Country pasture where we'll encounter some of the largest residents of Dogwood Canyon, American bison, elk, whitetail deer and Texas longhorn. Dogwood Canyon Mill and Grill is built right on Indian Creek and provides the perfect setting. Enjoy nature's beautiful surroundings while looking out to the cascading waterfall as we savor a variety of dining options. Following our tour, we have some time to relax at the hotel before our included dinner at a locally popular restaurant. After dinner, we arrive at the **Mansion Theater** to see the legendary **Oakridge Boys!** Although they've always been known for their country and gospel music, many of the Oak Ridge Boys songs crossed over onto the pop charts, including Elvira and Bobbie Sue. Their music has peppered the charts over the years, including number one champs like Touch a Hand, Make a Friend; Make My Life with You; American Made; (I'm Settin') Fancy Free; and It Takes a Little Rain (To Make Love Grow).

Day 4

Another included breakfast awaits us this morning before departing for **Branson Landing** for some shopping time and lunch on our own. Located on the shores of Lake Taneycomo with over 100 specialty shops, restaurants and national stores. Don't miss the magnificent water fountain spectacular, synchronized with water,

music and fire! This afternoon, we see our final show in Branson, **the #1 Hits of the 60's**. Voted Branson's "Best Matinee Show", #1 Hits of the 60's is back for its 16th fabulous season. This fun and exciting show takes us on a trip back in time with 100 costume changes and groovy song and dance numbers highlighting historic moments of the 60's. We have a final included dinner this evening before packing up to begin our journey home in the morning.

Day 5

Following our included breakfast this morning, we make our way to **Kimmswick, MO**; a charming, small Missouri town. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this historic Mississippi River town was established in 1859 and lovingly restored by its residents. We have an included lunch at the **Blue Owl Restaurant and Bakery** where "everything is homemade!" Be sure to check out their Levee High Apple Pie with Carmel Pecan Topping featured on the Food Network with Paula Deen! Following lunch, we have a little time in downtown Kimmswick to browse the many quaint and unique shops in original buildings surrounding the Blue Owl. After our shopping time, we visit **Fredmar Farms Anheuser Estate**, the former home of Mabel-Ruth and Frederick Anheuser. We will make our way through the quaint historic town of Kimmswick, over the Rock Creek Bridge and down a quiet country road a few hundred feet to their beautiful estate with the nation's greatest river for a back yard. Enjoy the splendor of the stately 95- year old Anheuser Estate on a guided tour and meander through its beautiful 23-acre park-like setting. We can take advantage of the hotel's complimentary light dinner and drinks or venture to one of two restaurants adjacent to the hotel.

Day 6

A final included breakfast greets us this morning as we pack our bags to make our final journey home stopping to stretch our legs and for meals on our own.
