Day 1

Thank you for joining us as we celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the Grand Ole Opry with many special centennial events. Our journey begins as we are greeted by our professional Bianco tour guide and driver. We will make plenty of stops along the way to Nashville, including time to get lunch and dinner on our own before arriving at the amazing **Gaylord Opryland Resort!** Expect an extraordinary experience as the resort boasts stylish rooms, 9 acres of lush, indoor gardens with cascading waterfalls, an indoor river, shops and restaurants all under one roof!

Day 2

A full breakfast buffet awaits us this morning before heading to **RCA Studio B** for a guided tour. Historic RCA Studio B is the home

of over 1,000 Top Ten hits! See where Elvis recorded over 200 songs! Explore the control room where the greats, like Chet Atkins, produced countless hits, and stars like Elvis, Dolly Parton, Elvis Presley, Marty Stuart, Martina McBride, Carrie Underwood, the Everly Brothers, Waylon Jennings, and Roy Orbison have all recorded. Next up we'll visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame & Museum**, the definitive home of America's music. It safeguards more than 2.5 million priceless artifacts, including countless recordings and photographs, numerous stage costumes, musical instruments, and more. This evening the Grand Ole Opry's 100th birthday celebration truly begins with a guided **Opry House Daytime Backstage Tour**, an exclusive **Pre-Opry dinner** catered by Ole Red in Studio A with

a special appearance by an Opry artist, main floor seats to the **Grand Ole Opry 100th Birthday Performance** and some special commemorative souvenirs..

Day 3

After another included breakfast buffet, we will visit “the mother church of country music,” **Ryman Auditorium** for a self-guided tour. Your visit to this famous National Historic Landmark begins with “Soul of Nashville,” a state-of-the-art theatre experience that puts you at the center of the Ryman’s fascinating history as more than a century of legendary performances come to life all around you. Enjoy five new exhibits where you can peruse genuine artifacts as video hosts take you through each chapter of the Ryman’s illustrious history. We then have some time to explore downtown Nashville on our own. This evening we will visit **Paula Deen’s Family Kitchen** for the **Lyrical Legends Dinner & Show**. In this up-close-and-personal experience, our group will enjoy a delicious meal and then be entertained by one of Nashville’s most successful songwriters. This is a unique opportunity to hear major hit songs in their original form and get the inside scoop on what was going on in the songwriter’s life that inspired these classics! In this interactive experience, groups are invited to ask questions about the songwriting process, such as, “How does a writer get paid?”, “How long does it take from the time you write your song until we hear it on the radio?” and any additional questions our group might have. There will be a meet & greet with the songwriter following the performance, where all members of the group will get a photo, autograph, and time to say “hello.”

Day 4

Enjoy another included breakfast buffet before checking out of the Opryland Resort and heading to **Loretta Lynn’s Ranch** for a tour and included lunch. We’ll tour Loretta’s Plantation Home, Frontier Homestead and a simulated coal mine. Then we can explore the Native American Artifact Museum, Grist Mill Museum (including Loretta’s fan and doll collection) and Loretta’s 18,000 square Coal Miner’s Daughter Museum. Next we’ll visit **Sun Studio** and take

a guided tour through the birthplace of rock 'n' roll where you will experience outtakes from recording sessions, touch Elvis' first microphone, and hear the real story of the studio that launched the careers of not only Elvis Presley, but also Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis, Carl Perkins, B.B. King, Roy Orbison, Charlie Rich, and many others that signed with the Sun label. This evening we will enjoy some award winning BBQ with an included dinner at **Marlowe’s Ribs & Restaurant**. Our home tonight is the **Guest House Graceland**. Located just steps away from the iconic Graceland Mansion, The Guest House at Graceland welcomes you with Southern hospitality, royal treatment and luxurious amenities that would make the king proud.

Day 5

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning and then we will enjoy the full Elvis experience that Graceland has to offer. We will have an audio-guided tour of the mansion and then we will have full access to the all-new Elvis Presley’s Memphis Entertainment Complex, which includes: Presley Motors Automobile Museum, Elvis: The Entertainer Career Museum, and Elvis Discovery Exhibits. After getting some lunch on our own we will have a tour of **Stax Museum of American Soul Music**. The tour starts with a short introductory video. From there you will see an amazing collection of more than 2,000 interactive exhibits, films, artifacts, items of memorabilia, galleries, and of course Isaac Hayes' gold-plated, peacock blue 1972 Superfly Cadillac El Dorado. Dinner this evening is included at **Blues City Café**. Located on Beale Street, this old-school juke joint/eatery specializes in the blues music & soul food of the Delta region. It is also where the movie “The Firm” was filmed. After dinner we will make our way back to a Nashville hotel for the night.
