Day 1

Today, we'll arrive in Portland with our Bianco Tour Director and we will be met by our local Motorcoach and Driver. After boarding our motorcoach, we will go for a get acquainted **tour of Portland** with a step on guide. At the end of the tour we will eat dinner at **The Chart House Restaurant**. Chart House offers a spectacular view of the Portland Skyline as well as spectacular food and service. After dinner we will check into our hotel and get some rest, remember we have some busy days ahead of us.

Day 2

Wake up and enjoy a continental breakfast before we head off to the **Rose Gardens**. We will have a tour of the gardens and some time to visit the Rose Garden Store. Our next stop is **Tillamook Cheese**. We'll have a self guided tour of the cheese making process and time for lunch on our own. To top off our visit here, an ice cream will be included to enjoy before departing for **Cannon Beach**. First discovered by William Clark of the Lewis and Clark Expedition, Cannon Beach is home to Haystack Rock, one of the largest "sea stacks" on America's Pacific Coast. Along with the nearby Needles Rocks, it is protected under Fish and Wildlife regulations as a Marine Garden and seabird nesting refuge. We have time to stroll the beach along the Pacific Ocean before returning to the hotel to freshen up before our included dinner at a locally popular restaurant.

Day 3

Good Morning! There is another continental breakfast waiting for us. We have a bite to eat and then we're on our way to take in the spectacular view of the Columbia River Gorge that is offered from the **Vista House** at the top of Crown Point. Vista House was built in 1916 on one of the most beautiful points on the Historic Columbia River Highway and is the most photographed icon on the Columbia River Gorge. Another beautiful view awaits us at the **Multnomah Lodge & Visitor's Center**. Plummeting 620 feet from its origins on Larch Mountain, Multnomah Falls is the second highest year around waterfall in the United States. We'll enjoy an included lunch at the Lodge after we've seen the falls, and then take a trip on the **Columbia Gorge Sternwheeler**. We'll learn the history of the Lewis and Clark Expedition and ride through the Cascade Locks. Before we return to the hotel for the night we'll enjoy some gourmet Pacific Northwest Cuisine prepared by an award winning culinary staff at the Timberline Lodge.

Day 4

This morning we will drive north out of Portland and pay a visit to the **Mt. St. Helen National Visitors Center**. Learn about the 1980 eruption that caused the largest landslide in recorded history and destroyed the previous landscape. Stopping at a couple view points along the way, we will have lunch on our own at the summit of this famous volcano. We'll visit **Johnston Ridge Observatory**, 5 miles from the crater for amazing views of Mount St. Helens and the blast zone. We'll drive by Mount Ranier arriving in Seattle this afternoon to check in at our hotel located right on scenic Lake Union. After time to freshen up at our hotel, dinner will be included at a locally popular restaurant on Seattle's colorful waterfront.

Day 5

Our fifth day starts with an included breakfast. Then its on the coach for a guided tour of Seattle. Our guide will take us on a **narrated tour** around this world-class city with many wonderful attractions and icons. The tour ends at the **Seattle**

Center, where we'll have time for lunch on our own and some shopping. Our four hour adventure to **Tillicum Village** on Blake Island begins with a 45-minute cruise where we can view the magnificent scenery. Upon arrival we will enjoy a cup of clams and broth as we enter the Longhouse. A cooking display shows whole salmon being cooked on cedar stakes over an alder wood fire in a traditional style of Northwest Coastal Natives. A buffet-style meal is included featuring the just-cooked salmon. As we finish our meal, the lights dim while the myth and magic come to life in the spellbinding performance featuring the Tillicum Village dancers. The dancers provide a performance which incorporates traditional stories, dances, and songs of Northwest Coastal Native groups. Following this unique visit, we'll cruise back to the mainland and return to our hotel for the evening.

Day 6

Another full breakfast buffet is included for us before we leave to visit the **Seattle Aquarium**. We can listen to the calls of the region's orca whales, stand within a circle of glowing jellyfish, run our fingers along a sea anemone's soft tentacles, and delight in the antics of the sea otters. From there we'll walk down to the **Pike Place Market** for some lunch on our own. See fish flying by at the fish market, sample locally produced foods and beverages, talk with local artists and discover some of Washington State's award winning boutique winemakers. Be sure to inhale the aromas wafting from shops and restaurants as you explore Pike Place Market's nooks and crannies. This afternoon, we visit **Chihuly Gardens and Glass** and the world famous **Seattle Space Needle**. See many of Dale Chihuly's glass artworks and stroll the beautiful gardens. Be sure to visit the Glass House showcasing an expansive 100-foot long sculpture in a colorful palette of reds, oranges, yellows and amber. Made of many individual elements, it is one of Chihuly's largest suspended sculptures. Then walk next door to the Space Needle. Located 500 feet above Seattle, the Observation Deck features 360 degrees of breathtaking indoor and outdoor viewing and colorful displays filled with facts and trivia. This evening dinner will be included in a locally popular Seattle restaurant.

Day 7

A final included breakfast greets us this morning as we prepare to depart for home, remembering the great times we had in America's Pacific Northwest.
