Day 1

This morning, we depart for Sault Ste Marie, MI with a cup of hot coffee and a snack served by a professional Bianco Tour Director. Rest and lunch stops on our own will be made for our comfort and convenience. We'll arrive this afternoon at the Kewadin Casino Hotel, our home for the next two nights. An incentive package will be included here for our gaming enjoyment. Dinner is included this evening at Antler's Restaurant. Located on the banks of the St. Mary's River, the Antler's is a legendary landmark with over 200 animal mounts everywhere in the restaurant.

Day 2

Breakfast is included this morning before departing for our full day in Sault Ste Marie, MI. Our first stop takes us to the Tower of History. Soaring 210 feet above Sault Ste Marie and the Soo Locks, the tower has observation platforms to get a bird's eye view of the world's busiest inland shipping channel. Next, we venture to the Museum Ship Valley Camp. This retired freighter offers more than just a tour of her deck. Housed inside her massive cargo holds is a 20,000 square foot museum with over 100 exhibits including the lifeboats torn away from the Edmund Fitzgerald on its fateful last night in 1975. This afternoon we enjoy shopping time and

lunch on our own in downtown Sault Ste Marie. Many shops and restaurants are located here along with the Soo Locks Viewing Platform and Visitor Center. This afternoon, we have time to relax at our hotel and freshen up before departing for the Soo Locks Dinner Cruise. Enjoy a relaxing cruise on the St Mary's River and sight-seeing in Sugar Island's North Channel as we enjoy a delicious buffet dinner. After dinner we'll tour through the Soo Locks, right alongside the big ships being raised 21 feet inside the Soo Locks to the level of Lake Superior. We'll see the American and Canadian Locks, St. Mary's Rapids and historic sights along the waterfront with the captain's narration.

Day 3

Following another included breakfast this morning we pack our bags and depart for the Point Iroquois Lighthouse. Now part of the Hiawatha National Forest, the lighthouse rests on a bluff above Lake Superior. Wooden walkways lead to the beach and the shore here is littered with unusual driftwood and agates. Tour the interior of the house with its period furnishings and antiques or climb the steps to the tower. This afternoon we have some shopping time and lunch on our own at Mackinaw Crossings located in Mackinaw City before departing for home.
