Day 1

This morning we depart for Shipshewana, IN; our home for the night in the middle of Amish country. Following lunch on our own this afternoon, a local step on guide will join us for the afternoon taking us on a “**brown bag**” tour of the area. We stop at Amish sites along the way, including **Linton’s Enchanted Gardens, Dutch Country Market, Spring Valley Woodcraft and Deutsch Kase Haus**. The award-winning Linton’s Enchanted Gardens, Indiana’s largest Home and Garden Center, is the number one attraction in the area with a variety of beautiful display gardens. At the Dutch Country Market and Deutsch Kase Haus, we have a chance to pick up some Amish treats to take home with us while learning about traditional and simple Amish cooking. During an interesting visit to Spring Valley Woodcraft, we’ll meet the owner, LaVern Miller. LaVern has been in this custom woodworking business for more than 30 years and will talk with us about the coffins and caskets he hand crafts. We’ll collect gifts along the way to fill our brown bag while learning about the area and the life of the Amish. After check in at the **Farmstead Inn**, we depart for dinner at the **Blue Gate Restaurant**. Enjoy a family style feast of Amish home cooking and relax on one of the many gliders that line the beautiful wrap around porch or shop in the gift shops and bakery. The remainder of the evening is ours to enjoy.

Day 2

This morning we have an included continental breakfast before departing for the **Rise ’n Roll Bakery**. We will have some shopping time here before departing for the **Shipshewana Flea Market**. The Midwest’s largest flea market with nearly 900 booths in an open-air market covering 100 acres. Vendors offer a variety of products and truly have something for everyone; vintage items, quirky novelties, hand-made goods, re-purposed crafts, handcrafted furniture, home decor and much more. Lunch is included this afternoon in an authentic Amish home, the **Carriage House**. The Haystack, a signature meal for the Amish in this area, our host Elaine, tells the story of the Haystack meal that is served at Amish fundraisers staged to help out when there’s a crisis in the community. The Haystack received fame when a group of area Amish school children, submitted it to Newman’s Own recipe contest and won! After lunch, we have some free time for shopping the quaint and unique shops in downtown Shipshewana before departing for home. An on our own dinner stop will be made en route.
