### Day 1

This morning we begin our fall foliage adventure to Vermont, the Green Mountain State, with a cup of coffee and a snack served by a professional Bianco Tour Director. We make our way into Corning, NY today; our home for the night. Dinner is included at a locally popular restaurant before checking into our hotel.

### Day 2

Following an included breakfast this morning, we depart for the **Corning Museum of Glass**. Nearly 50,000 objects representing more than 3,500 years of history are displayed in the galleries; items range from the portrait of an ancient Egyptian pharaoh to contemporary sculpture. We'll make a lunch stop on our own this afternoon prior to arriving in Brattleboro, VT. Following check in

at our hotel, we'll enjoy dinner at a modern, yet rustic restaurant with a New England atmosphere.

### Day 3

Another included breakfast awaits us this morning before departing for the **Vermont Country Store**, filled with locally made products and hundreds of items that will bring fond memories. On the grounds, take a stroll through the Kissing Bridge or visit the Grist Mill Museum and see hand-made equipment once used to harness the power of water. This afternoon, we arrive at the **Green Mountain Railroad** for a fall foliage trip from Chester to Ludlow, VT. Enjoy beautiful views and historical narration and ride over a high trestle with stunning views of Ludlow while we enjoy an included boxed lunch provided by a local market. After our ride, we will make our way towards Burlington, VT stopping at

the **Quechee Gorge** for a picture stop. "Vermont's Little Grand Canyon" is the phrase thrown around to describe the beautiful mile long gorge. Dinner is included at an award winning farm to table restaurant with a wood fired grill before checking into our hotel in Burlington, home for the next three nights.

### Day 4

After our included breakfast this morning, we depart for **Stowe, VT**; a ski and resort town just west of Burlington. On arrival, we pick up our step on guide who will be with us for the day to make sure we experience all that Stowe has to offer. We'll take a **guided tour of Ben & Jerry's**, and learn how they make their famous ice cream and how they put their values into action at every step of the process. After a chance to try an ice cream and stroll through the flavor graveyard, we have a little shopping time at **Cabot Cheese and Lake Champlain Chocolates**. Also located here is **Smugglers Notch Distillery** if anyone would like to sample some spirits. We drive by **Emily's Covered Bridge** and hear different tales of the haunted bridge and the love story that goes with it before arriving in **Stowe Village** for some shopping time and lunch on our own. A sightseeing tour of Stowe Village is next on the agenda as we take in the peerless mountain scenery and sites of Vermont's highest peak: "Mount Mansfield, the ski capitol of the east". Ride through Moscow, Vermont and hear about the shortest fourth of July parade in the nation. Following our ride around Stowe, we visit the **Cold Hollow Cider Mill** for samples of the fresh pressed apple cider and cider donuts, named one of the best in the country by Gourmet Magazine. Cold Hollow Cider Mill is a top New England producer of fresh apple cider and one of Vermont's most popular attractions. It's because they do it the real old-fashioned way, making real cider with a traditional rack and cloth press built in the 1920's. Dinner is included this evening at a popular restaurant in Montpelier, the Capitol of Vermont. We will dine in the shadows of the Vermont State House, one of the oldest and best preserved of our nation's capitols.

### Day 5

We have another included breakfast this morning before departing for downtown Burlington for a cruise aboard the **Spirit of Ethan Allen**, the only cruise ship located on Lake Champlain. See spectacular views of the city, the Green Mountains of Vermont and the New York Adirondacks. **Downtown Burlington**, Vermont's award-winning open air mall is a hub of activity where we'll find over 100 places to shop and dine, historic architecture, street entertainers, live music and more! We have a chance to get some lunch on our own and do some shopping. After some time to freshen up at the hotel, we depart for **Dakin Farm**. The Sugarhouse at Dakin Farm has been used to boil sap every season for over 58 years! We see a short film about the history of making maple syrup, visit the Sugarhouse, the smokehouse and see equipment used to make maple syrup dating back to the 1800's. Dinner this evening is included at the **Waybury Inn**. The Waybury Inn in Middlebury, Vermont is located in a very special place between the base of the Green Mountains and the scenic town center, with beautiful Lake Champlain just beyond. For nearly a decade, Bob Newhart entertained audiences with his hit TV show, Newhart. Newhart was filmed at the Waybury Inn for almost 10 years and we have an opportunity to see some of the memorabilia from the show.

### Day 6

After our included breakfast this morning, we begin our journey home traveling through the beautiful Adirondack Mountains with it's lovely fall colors before arriving in **Niagara Falls, NY**; our home for the night. Dinner is included at a beautiful restaurant located inside the Niagara Falls State Park on Goat Island featuring panoramic views of Horseshoe Falls through floor-to-ceiling windows.

### Day 7

Following our included breakfast this morning and before departing for our final journey home, we board the **Maid of the Mist Boat** for a ride to get up close and personal with the Niagara Falls. See the raging currents, hear the deafening thunder and feel the refreshing mist of 600,000 gallons of water falling before our eyes every second. We return home this evening with wonderful memories of our autumn visit to Vermont!
