





## Day 1

Our adventure to New England begins this morning with a scenic drive to Lewisburg, PA; home for the evening. Upon arrival at our quaint hotel, dinner is included with time to shop in their gift shops. Be sure to rest up for our journey to Cape Cod tomorrow.

# Day 2

After an included breakfast, we depart for the village of Hyannis, MA on historic Cape Cod. Considered to be the hub and heart of Cape Cod, Hyannis is know internationally as the "All-American City". The Cape Codder Resort and Spa is our home for the next three nights arriving just in time for an included dinner. With amazing amenities, there is plenty for us to do for the rest of the evening as we enjoy our first night on the Cape.

# <u>Day 3</u>

This morning, we depart on an all day tour of Cape Cod and **Provincetown** with a local step on guide. Narrating along the way, our guide takes us by the Kennedy Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Hyannisport and St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer parish of the Kennedy Family. As we travel along Old King's Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history, we see Eastham Windmill and a Cape Cod Lighthouse before arriving at the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor's Center for a visit. Sand dunes and the ocean surround us as we approach "Land's End" - Provincetown. Located at the extreme tip of Cape Cod and steeped in history, Provincetown is the site of the first landing place of the Mayflower Pilgrims in the New World almost 400 years ago. We take time some time for shopping and lunch on our own before returning to our hotel to freshen up. Dinner is included this evening at an amazing waterfront restaurant featuring a beautiful sunset and harbor views.

# **Day 4**

This morning we stop at **Cape Cod Potato Chip Factory** to see how these legendary chips are made and pick up some snacks for our remaining days before departing on a **Whale Watcher Cruise** sure to take our breath away. The jet powered, state-of-the-art vessel; Whale Watcher carries us to Stellwagen Bank National Marine Sanctuary for unforgettable encounters with the whales; the seasonal

Humpback, Finback and Minke whales and several dolphin species. The waters around Cape Cod consistently rank as one of the world's top 10 whale watching destinations. The trip is led by experienced captains and is narrated by expert naturalists who will show us how to spot whales as well as give us information on each species and answer any questions we have. We pass acres of coastal salt marsh and a barrier beach system called Sandy Neck, an historic cottage colony with a 150 year old lighthouse and much more. After our trip, we have some time to relax and freshen up before departing for dinner at a well-known Cape Cod landmark.

#### <u>Day 5</u>

Today we pack our bags and head out to Kennebunkport, ME. For well over a century the town has been a popular summer colony now boasting it is the place to be all year. Upon arrival, we have time for lunch on our own and shopping in **Dock Square** with it's unique gift shops, fine dining, blowing cave and spouting rock prior to departing on a guided tour of **Kennebunkport** with a local step on guide. Settled in the 1600's and a long time ship building mecca, sea captains built fine mansions preserved today as lovely inns with unique charm. See the sandy beaches and coastline, pass George Bush's estate at Walker's Point, hear the history of the ship building towns and the legend of the Wedding Cake House and visit the seaside shrines and chapel. Following our tour, we check into our resort style hotel and have a wine and cheese reception as we relax and settle in. En route to dinner this evening in York Harbor, we stop in Cape Neddick at Nubble Lighthouse, Maine's southernmost lighthouse, for a photo opportunity. A **Down East Clambake**, a time honored tradition in Maine and a feast to be remembered, is included this evening with sing-a-long entertainment.

## Day 6

After an included breakfast this morning, we begin our journey toward home overnighting in the Finger Lakes region of New York, known for its distinctive wines and beautiful scenery. Dinner this evening is a three hour **dinner cruise on Skaneateles Lake** while viewing steep and wooded hill sides, Glacier carved hillsides and crystal clear water.

#### Day 7

Breakfast is included again this morning before completing our journey home making rest & meal stops for our comfort & convenience.
